Concord, NC – Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers will be offering mammography services at McGill Family Medicine and Dental Clinic.

In October 2022, CRCHC partnered with Invision Diagnostic to provide mammography services through its mammogram mobile unit. Now, CRCHC will be providing in-house mammography services. With in-house mammography services, patients will have increased access to this important screening tool.

Mammograms are an essential part of women’s health and can detect potential issues early on, which can lead to better outcomes and treatment options. Having these services available in-house means that patients won't have to go through the hassle of scheduling appointments at separate facilities or traveling long distances. It's a convenient option that will hopefully encourage more women to prioritize their breast health. With the support of Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers, women in the area can feel confident that their healthcare needs are being met in a comprehensive and accessible manner.

Uninsured patients can get free or reduced-cost mammograms. CRCHC will provide information for the NC Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP) during the patient visit and/or other organization information. The patient can contact BCCCP or any other organization to confirm eligibility. After being approved for funding, the patient can call the facility of their choice to schedule an appointment.

Finding breast cancer early and getting state-of-the-art cancer treatment are two of the most important strategies for preventing deaths from breast cancer. Breast cancer that’s found early, when it’s small and has not spread, is easier to treat successfully. Getting regular screening tests is the most reliable way to find breast cancer early. The American Cancer Society (ACS) recommends breast cancer screenings for women 50 - 55 every year, and 56 - 74 years of age every two years. “We are excited to be able to provide these services at our location.
