Sugar Creek Health Center is now open in the Charlotte area. The new clinic offers a wide range of medical services to the local community, including women’s health, pediatrics, chronic disease management, behavioral health services, and dental care. The health center is staffed by a team of highly trained medical professionals who provide top-quality care to patients of all ages.

The clinic also offers a sliding fee scale for patients that may be uninsured. The sliding fee scale allows the organization to discount a patient’s services based on their income and family size. Families that qualify for a discount under the sliding scale will be asked to pay a nominal fee. CRCHC’s mobile unit held remote clinics onsite on November 8th until the physical opening of the new clinic.
