



CRCHC Receives Funding from The Cannon Foundation for Northern Rowan Family Medicine Expansion

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Spencer, NC - CRCHC is pleased to announce that the organization has received funding from The Cannon Foundation to expand the Northern Rowan Family Medicine Location.

Northern Rowan Family Medicine, located in Spencer, North Carolina, serves patients living in rural areas of Rowan County.
