**Charlotte, NC** - CRCHC is pleased to announce that the organization is partnering with Charlotte Rescue Mission to provide primary care and behavioral health services.

Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers has partnered with the [Charlotte Rescue Mission](#) to provide primary care and behavioral health services through the mobile unit. The mobile unit will alternate between the Men's and Women's shelters every Monday. Primary Care services will be provided from 9 AM – 3 PM and Behavioral Health services from 9 AM – 12 PM. This initiative aims to bridge the gap in healthcare access for individuals experiencing homelessness, ensuring they receive comprehensive medical and mental health support. The primary care services will include routine check-ups, vaccinations, and management of chronic conditions, while the behavioral health services will offer counseling, mental health screenings, and support for substance use disorders.

Founded in 1938 by a group of Christian business individuals, the Charlotte Rescue Mission serves those facing homelessness. Because many individuals seeking assistance from the Mission in its initial years were dealing with addiction issues, the Mission decided to shift its focus toward addiction recovery. The partnership between Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers and the Charlotte Rescue Mission is a testament to the strength of community partnerships in addressing public health challenges. By bringing healthcare directly to the shelters, the mobile unit reduces barriers such as transportation and stigma, fostering a more inclusive approach to wellness.

We are continuously working to break down barriers that prevent individuals from receiving the care they need.
